Facilitating communication and the exchange of ideas among Central Region chapters of IPMA-HR

President

(1 year term directly following term as President-Elect)

The President conducts the business of the Region in accordance with the bylaws and rules of the Region and chairs the Board of Directors. The President presides over all business sessions and appoints all Region committees and non-voting members to the Board of Directors. The President has general active management of the business of the Region and sees that orders and resolutions of the board are carried into effect.

President-Elect

(1 year term, with commitment to serve as President and Past President)

The President-Elect acts in the absence of the President. The President-Elect serves as program chair for the annual regional conference and performs such other duties as the President shall prescribe.

Immediate Past President

(1 year term directly following term as President)

The Immediate Past President serves as a member of the Board of Directors with the primary function of being an advisor. The Immediate Past President is expected to assume additional duties in the event of a vacancy on the Board of Directors.

Secretary

(1 year term)

The Secretary records and keeps the Region's records and minutes and fulfills the usual duties required by such office. The Secretary also coordinates the business affairs of the annual meeting of the Region, assists the President-Elect in their role as program chair, provides assistance as needed to the Treasurer and submits reports of Region proceedings and activities to the IPMA-HR headquarters.

Treasurer

(2 year term)

The Treasurer keeps accurate financial records for the Region, deposits money and drafts checks, and upon request, provides the President and the Board an account of transactions. The Treasurer also prepares a complete itemized report of all receipts and disbursements after the close of the annual meeting, that is subject to the approval of an Audit Committee.

Regional Rep to IPMA-HR Executive Council

(3 year term & must have IPMA-CP or IPMA-SCP)

The Regional Representative represents the Region on the National Executive Council, while serving as a voting member of the Regional Board of Directors. The Regional Representative submits a report at the annual meeting on those activities of IPMA-HR which affect the organization.

Expand Your Possibilities on the Central Region Board of Directors!

Officers of the Central Region consist of, at minimum, a President, Immediate Past President, President-Elect, Treasurer, Secretary, and Regional Representative to the Executive Council. The Regional Representative to the Executive Council, President-Elect, Treasurer and Secretary are elected by the Region's voting members, whereas, the Immediate Past President and President typically come from the ranks of President-Elect and President.

Serving on the Central Region Board of Directors is a little different from serving at the local level. Board meetings are held monthly and are accomplished via teleconferences, which last approximately one hour. All Board Members work collaboratively to carry on the business of the Region and lead the planning efforts for the Regional Conference.

There are also great benefits to serving as a Board Member! You will have the opportunity to network and collaborate with a wide variety of HR colleagues from across the Midwest and the nation. You will also have the honor and distinction of leading our organization and shaping the face of the organization for future Human Resources professionals.

Serving as a Board Member has it's perks too! As a Board Member you can help your organization's training dollars go much further. The Region may cover the registration and travel costs of Board Members to attend the IPMA-HR Central Region Conference. Registration and travel expenses will also be provided for the President and President-Elect to attend the International IPMA-HR Conference if their employer is unable to cover the expenses. For the President-Elect, the Region will also cover the travel expenses to attend the National Leadership Conference.
